

# PLUMILIFORM

*Meaning: Plumiliform refers to having a feather-like or downy appearance, often evoking a light, airy, or ethereal quality.*

1. The artist's brush strokes created a plumiliform effect that made the painting appear almost ethereal.
2. In her description of the bird, she noted its plumiliform feathers that resembled delicate wisps of smoke.
