

PNEUMATOCYST

Meaning: Pneumatocyst: a gas-filled bladder in certain aquatic plants, particularly seaweeds, that aids in buoyancy and keeps the plant afloat for sunlight exposure.

1. The pneumatocyst of the seaweed helps it float to the surface for sunlight.
2. Researchers studied the structure of the pneumatocyst to understand its buoyancy mechanisms.
3. In certain species of algae, the pneumatocyst can vary significantly in size and shape.
4. The presence of a pneumatocyst is crucial for the survival of some aquatic plants in turbulent waters.
5. During their life cycle, many marine organisms rely on the pneumatocyst for efficient photosynthesis.
