Meaning: Polled: to survey or question a group of people in order to gather their opinions or feedback on a specific topic.

1. The researchers polled a diverse group of participants to gather opinions on climate change.
2. After the event, the organizers polled the attendees to assess their satisfaction with the program.
3. In the latest survey, voters were polled about their preferences for the upcoming election.
4. The company polled its employees to understand their views on the new remote work policy.
5. She polled her friends to see which restaurant they preferred for dinner that night.
