Meaning: To posit means to put forward or suggest an idea, theory, or assumption for consideration or discussion.

1. The philosopher decided to posit a new theory about the nature of existence.
2. In her research paper, she chose to posit that climate change is accelerating at an unprecedented rate.
3. During the debate, he would often posit counterarguments that challenged the prevailing views.
4. The scientist was careful to posit his findings within the context of existing literature.
5. To foster discussion, the teacher asked the students to posit potential solutions to the problem.
