

POST-MORTEM

Meaning: A post-mortem is an analysis or evaluation conducted after an event to examine its outcomes and identify causes of failure or issues.

1. The team held a post-mortem to analyze what went wrong during the project.
2. After the accident, a post-mortem investigation was conducted to determine the cause.
3. In their post-mortem, they discussed both successes and failures in the campaign.
4. The medical examiner performed a post-mortem to establish the time of death.
5. Following the game, the coach and players participated in a post-mortem to review their performance.
