

POST-TYMPANIC

Meaning: Post-tympanic refers to a surgical or diagnostic approach or measurement that takes place behind or after the tympanic membrane (eardrum) in the context of ear-related procedures or assessments.

1. The post-tympanic approach is often favored in complex ear surgeries.
2. In audiology, post-tympanic measurements can reveal valuable information about middle ear function.
3. Following the post-tympanic procedure, the patient reported a significant reduction in hearing difficulties.
4. The study focused on post-tympanic complications that may arise after surgery.
5. Researchers noted that post-tympanic changes in pressure could affect overall auditory perception.

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
