Meaning: Postposit (verb): To place a word or phrase after the word it modifies, particularly in the context of syntax.

1. In some languages, certain adjectives are commonly postposit, appearing after the nouns they modify.
2. The term "postposit" refers specifically to the syntactic positioning of elements in a sentence.
3. Linguists often analyze how postposit structures can affect the meaning of a phrase.
4. When translating poetry, one must consider whether to postposit adjectives for stylistic effect.
5. In English, most adjectives are placed before nouns, but some phrases can be postposit for emphasis.
