

POSTSCAPULAR

Meaning: Postscapular refers to the area or anatomical structures located behind the scapula (shoulder blade) in vertebrates.

1. The postscapular region is crucial for understanding the anatomy of the shoulder.
2. In some species, the postscapular bone plays a significant role in their locomotion.
3. Researchers have identified a unique muscle that originates in the postscapular area of the scapula.
4. The postscapular surface is often examined in studies of muscular development in vertebrates.
5. During surgery, careful attention must be paid to the postscapular nerves to avoid complications.
