Meaning: Postscenium: the area behind the main stage in a theater, often used for additional scenes or reflections following the climax of a performance.

1. The postscenium of the theater provided a unique backdrop for the final scenes of the play.
2. In many classical dramas, the postscenium was used to convey the characters' reflections after the climax.
3. The director cleverly utilized the postscenium to transition between the intense action and a more intimate resolution.
