

POTLATCH

Meaning: Potlatch is a ceremonial event among Indigenous peoples of the Pacific Northwest where hosts distribute wealth and gifts to strengthen social ties and community relationships.

1. The potlatch ceremony is a significant cultural event among many Indigenous peoples of the Pacific Northwest.
2. During the potlatch, hosts distribute wealth and gifts to reinforce social ties and community relationships.
3. Anthropologists studied the potlatch to understand its role in social status and economic systems among Native tribes.
4. In preparation for the potlatch, families often gather resources and create elaborate gifts to present to their guests.
5. The decline of the potlatch was a result of government policies aimed at assimilating Indigenous cultures into mainstream society.

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
