

PRATINCOLE

Meaning: Pratincole: a type of wading bird belonging to the family Glareolidae, characterized by long wings, a slender body, and typically found in open habitats near water.

1. The pratincole soared gracefully above the wetlands, its slender wings catching the sunlight.
2. During our birdwatching trip, we were thrilled to spot a rare pratincole perched on a distant tree branch.
3. The unique feeding habits of the pratincole include skimming over the water to catch insects on the wing.
