

PRECIPITABLE

Meaning: Precipitable refers to the capability of a substance, such as moisture or ions, to be separated or caused to fall out of a solution or atmosphere, often resulting in precipitation.

1. The sudden change in temperature was precipitable, leading to unexpected rain showers.
2. In the lab, we studied the precipitable ions that could affect the outcome of the reaction.
3. Her excitement was precipitable, easily flaring up at the mention of her favorite band.
4. The storm's intensity was precipitable, causing concern among meteorologists.
5. Small fluctuations in pressure can result in precipitable moisture that contributes to local flooding.
