Meaning: Preclusion refers to the act of preventing or excluding something from consideration or participation.

1. The preclusion of certain evidence from the trial significantly impacted the jury's decision.
2. Her preclusion from participating in the conference was a disappointment for the entire team.
3. The legal doctrine of preclusion prevents parties from relitigating issues that have already been settled.
4. Due to the preclusion of outside opinions, the committee was able to maintain a focused discussion.
5. He faced preclusion in his application due to a lack of required documentation.
