*Meaning: Precogitation refers to the act of foreseeing or anticipating future events or outcomes.*

1. Her precogitation of the events allowed her to prevent the disaster before it occurred.
2. The artist's precogitation inspired a series of paintings that seemed to predict future societal trends.
3. In moments of quiet reflection, he often relied on his precogitation to guide his decisions.
4. The scientist marveled at the precogitation displayed in the patterns of nature around him.
5. Despite skepticism from his peers, his precogitation proved accurate when the crisis unfolded just as he had foreseen.
