

PRECONCEIT

Meaning: Preconceit refers to an opinion or judgment formed in advance, often based on insufficient evidence, which can distort perception and understanding.

1. Preconceit often clouds our judgment and prevents us from seeing the truth.
2. His preconceit about the new policy led to unnecessary resistance among the employees.
3. To overcome preconceit, one must be willing to listen to differing perspectives.
4. The artist's work challenges the preconceit of traditional beauty standards in society.
5. She approached the discussion with a preconceit that hindered meaningful dialogue.
