Meaning: To preconform means to adapt or shape something in advance to meet specific standards or requirements.

1. To preconform to the industry standards, the team revised their design plans thoroughly.
2. The material must preconform under heat to ensure it maintains its shape during production.
3. She decided to preconform her ideas to fit the expectations of the committee.
4. In order to succeed, the project must preconform to the regulatory requirements set forth.
5. The research indicated that organisms often preconform their behaviors based on environmental cues.
