

PRECONSENT

Meaning: Preconsent refers to the prior agreement or approval obtained from individuals or stakeholders, typically to ensure informed participation or compliance in a specific context, such as clinical trials or projects.

1. Preconsent is often required in clinical trials to ensure participants are fully informed.
