1. The author included a prefatory note that explained the inspiration behind the book.
2. In her prefatory remarks, she thanked everyone who contributed to the project.
3. The prefatory chapter sets the tone for the entire novel, introducing key themes and characters.
4. He found the prefatory section of the report to be more insightful than the main analysis itself.
5. A prefatory acknowledgment is often a heartfelt way to express gratitude to mentors and supporters.
