

PREFORMATION

Meaning: Preformation is the theory that organisms develop from pre-existing forms or that an artist's vision is fully conceived prior to the creative process.

1. The preformation theory was a popular concept in early developmental biology.
2. In the context of art, preformation refers to the idea that an artist's vision is fully formed before the creative process begins.
3. Some philosophers argue that preformation limits our understanding of how ideas evolve over time.
4. The preformation of genetic traits can be seen in certain inherited characteristics among family members.
5. In discussions about embryology, the term preformation often arises when contrasting with epigenesis.
