Meaning: To preindispose is to make someone more susceptible or likely to develop a particular condition or response due to certain factors.

1. Certain genetic factors can preindispose individuals to developing certain health conditions.
2. A history of trauma may preindispose someone to anxiety and stress-related disorders.
3. Living in an environment with high pollution can preindispose residents to respiratory issues.
4. Childhood experiences can preindispose adults to various personality traits and behaviors.
5. Some people may be preindisposed to addiction due to a combination of genetic and environmental influences.
