Meaning: PREJUDICATELY: In a manner that shows bias or preconceived judgment, often leading to unfair conclusions or decisions.

1. The jury's decision was made prejudicately, reflecting their biases rather than the evidence presented.
2. She felt that the report prejudicated her reputation before the facts were fully examined.
3. His prejudicately formed opinions on the subject limited the depth of the discussion.
4. The committee acted prejudicately, denying opportunities to candidates based on unfounded assumptions.
5. It is crucial to avoid prejudicately judging others based on stereotypes and misconceptions.
