Meaning: Prelimit: to set a restriction or limit in advance on the number of participants or entries allowed in an event or process.

1. The committee decided to prelimit the number of participants to ensure a more manageable event.
2. In an effort to streamline the process, the organizers chose to prelimit submissions to the first fifty entries.
3. The software allows users to prelimit their search results based on specific criteria for better accuracy.
4. To avoid overwhelming the staff, the school administration will prelimit the number of students attending the trip.
5. She suggested that they prelimit the discussion topics to stay focused and make the meeting more productive.
