*Meaning: Prelook (verb): To review or examine something in advance, typically to prepare for a future task or event.*

3. She asked her colleague to prelook the data analysis to catch any possible mistakes.
4. Before finalizing the design, the architect wanted to prelook the floor plans for functionality.
5. The editor agreed to prelook the manuscript for inconsistencies before sending it to print.
