Meaning: Preclusive: serving to prevent or exclude something from happening or being considered.

2. Her remarks were preclusive, shutting down any possibility of open discussion.
3. The preclusive evidence presented in court ultimately swayed the jury's opinion.
4. His dismissal of the project was preclusive, leaving no room for reconsideration.
5. The preclusive terms of the contract caught many investors off guard.
