Meaning: Prenostic: serving as a sign or indication of something that is about to happen.

1. The darkening sky served as a prenostic of the approaching storm.
2. In ancient cultures, certain animal behaviors were considered prenostic signs of upcoming events.
3. Her dreams often felt prenostic, hinting at changes in her life before they occurred.
4. The sudden chill in the air was a prenostic of the winter to come.
5. Many believed that a lunar eclipse was a prenostic of significant societal shifts.
