Meaning: To prerequire means to establish a necessary condition or requirement that must be met before proceeding with a particular action or opportunity.

1. The job prerequisites will prerequire candidates to have at least five years of relevant experience.
2. Before enrolling in the advanced course, students must prerequire a foundational understanding of the subject.
3. The new software update may prerequire additional hardware modifications for optimal performance.
4. To participate in the elite training program, applicants must prerequire certain fitness assessments.
5. Her research proposal will prerequire approval from the ethics committee before proceeding.
