Meaning: PREROGATIVELY: in a manner that reflects the exercise of a special right or privilege to make decisions independently.

1. The committee decided prerogatively to change the meeting date to accommodate everyone's schedule.
2. In her role as CEO, she acted prerogatively, making decisions that would steer the company towards success.
3. He used his prerogatively to award the contract to the firm he believed could deliver the best results.
4. The president exercised his prerogatively to veto the bill, sparking a heated debate among lawmakers.
5. As the lead artist, she could prerogatively choose the theme of the upcoming exhibition without consultation.
