

PRESCAPULAR

Meaning: PRESCAPULAR: relating to the area located in front of the scapula (shoulder blade), often associated with muscle attachment and lymph nodes in animals.

1. The prescapular region of the animal is critical for the attachment of muscles used in movement.
2. Veterinarians often examine the prescapular lymph nodes during health assessments of pets.
3. Anatomists studied the prescapular area to understand its role in shoulder function.
4. During surgery, the doctor carefully navigated around the prescapular muscles to avoid complications.
5. In certain mammals, the prescapular area exhibits distinct features that aid in species identification.

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
