1. She had a presentiment that something significant was about to happen.
2. His presentiment of failure loomed over him as he approached the final exam.

4. The storm clouds gathered on the horizon, filling her with a presentiment of impending danger.
5. Although he couldn't explain it, a presentiment told him to be cautious about the new business deal.
