Meaning: To presignify means to indicate or suggest in advance the meaning or outcome of something.

1. To presignify the outcome, the researchers carefully designed their experiment.
2. The artist aimed to presignify the themes of loss and redemption in her latest work.
3. In his speech, he sought to presignify the challenges the community would face in the coming years.
4. The novel's opening chapter seemed to presignify the tragic events that unfolded later.
5. By using symbolism, the director was able to presignify the film's central conflict early on.
