

PRESUME

Meaning: To assume something is true based on reasonable evidence or belief without complete proof.

1. I presume that you have already informed her about the meeting.
2. It's easy to presume someone's intentions without knowing the full story.
3. Before jumping to conclusions, we should presume innocence until proven otherwise.
4. I presume you'll be joining us for dinner later this evening.
5. She didn't want to presume too much about his feelings for her.
6. I presume you've already completed the assignment.
7. Without any evidence, it's risky to presume someone's intentions.
8. Given the weather forecast, I presume it will rain later today.
9. She didn't respond, so I can only presume she's busy.
10. In the absence of any contrary evidence, we can presume the theory is correct.
