Meaning: Priming is the psychological process by which exposure to certain stimuli influences an individual's subsequent thoughts, behaviors, or decisions, often without conscious awareness.

1. Priming can significantly influence our decisions without us even realizing it.
2. The experiment demonstrated that priming with positive words improved participants' mood.
3. In marketing, priming is used to subtly shape consumer perceptions of a brand.
4. Psychologists often study priming to understand how memory and cognition are interconnected.
5. By priming students with specific concepts, teachers can enhance their learning outcomes.
