

PROBATION

Meaning: Probation is a period of supervised release from jail or prison during which an individual must comply with certain conditions instead of serving time in custody.

1. The judge sentenced him to a year of probation instead of jail time.
2. After successfully completing her probation, she was able to find a stable job.
3. The company placed him on probation as a precautionary measure following the incident.
4. He was relieved to learn that his probation would be lifted early due to good behavior.
5. During his probation period, he had to check in with his officer every week.
