

PROBATIONAL

Meaning: Probational refers to a trial period during which an individual's performance or suitability is evaluated before a permanent status is granted.

1. The employee was placed on a probational period to assess her fit within the team.
2. After completing her training, she entered a probational phase before being offered a permanent position.
3. The probational status allowed the company to evaluate the new hire's performance over a few months.
4. During the probational term, the manager provided regular feedback to help the employee improve.
5. He understood that his actions during the probational stage would significantly influence his future at the company.
