

PROBATIVE

Meaning: Probative refers to evidence or testimony that is capable of proving something relevant or material in a legal context.

1. The witness's testimony was deemed probative and played a crucial role in the jury's decision.
2. In court, only evidence that is probative of a fact can be admitted for consideration.
3. The lawyer argued that the new piece of evidence was highly probative to the defendant's innocence.
4. Judges routinely assess whether the probative value of evidence outweighs its potential prejudicial effect.
5. A thorough investigation can uncover probative details that significantly impact the outcome of a case.
