

PROCHRONIZE

Meaning: Prochronize (verb): to schedule or arrange events or tasks to occur earlier than originally planned or to present information ahead of its formal completion.

1. The committee decided to prochronize the project's timeline to ensure all tasks were completed ahead of schedule.
2. In an effort to prochronize their research findings, the scientists released preliminary data before the final results were published.
3. She tends to prochronize important meetings, often moving them forward to allow for unexpected delays later.
4. To prochronize the event, the organizers arranged for speakers to present their topics earlier than planned.
5. By prochronizing the delivery dates, the company aimed to enhance customer satisfaction and minimize wait times.
