Meaning: Proclive: inclined or disposed to a particular behavior or tendency, especially in a way that suggests a readiness to engage in it.

3. The children were proclive to mischief, turning every quiet moment into a playful chaos.
4. In the meeting, her proclive tendency to criticize without offering solutions was noted by her colleagues.
5. The scientist was proclive to explore unconventional theories, which sometimes led to groundbreaking discoveries.
