

PROD

Meaning: Prod (verb): To poke or jab with a pointed object or to nudge someone gently to elicit a response or action.

1. The farmer used a long stick to prod the stubborn sheep back into the pen.
2. She gave him a gentle prod in the side to get his attention during the meeting.
3. To encourage the team, the manager decided to prod them with weekly performance reviews.
4. He had to prod the old engine several times before it finally roared to life.
5. The teacher would often prod her students to think critically about the material.
6. The farmer decided to prod the stubborn cow to move towards the barn.
7. She used a stick to prod the sleeping dog awake for their morning walk.
8. The manager's decision to prod the team for updates helped keep the project on track.
9. As the debate heated up, he felt the need to prod his opponent into revealing their true stance.
10. During the meeting, she would often prod her colleagues to share their ideas more freely.
