Meaning: To prod means to poke or jab someone or something with a pointed object or to encourage someone to take action or engage.

1. She used a stick to prodd the sleeping dog gently, trying to wake it up.
2. The teacher had to prodd the students to participate more actively in the discussion.
3. As they walked through the dense forest, they would prodd the underbrush to check for hidden treasures.
4. He prodded the clay with his fingers, shaping it into a beautiful sculpture.
5. Despite their reluctance, the coach had to prodd the team to give their best effort during practice.
