1. The cost of the new technology was prohibitively high for most small businesses.
2. Her lack of experience in the field proved to be a prohibitively large obstacle in securing the job.
3. The regulations were so prohibitively strict that many applicants chose not to apply at all.
4. Traveling abroad can often feel prohibitively expensive for students on a tight budget.
5. The school's prohibitively long application process discouraged many potential candidates from applying.
