Meaning: Proleptically refers to a narrative technique that anticipates or foreshadows future events or outcomes within a story.

1. The author proleptically hints at the tragic fate of the protagonist in the opening chapters.
2. In her lecture, she explained how the concept of proleptic narration can create suspense in storytelling.
3. The film's use of proleptic imagery allows viewers to anticipate the climax long before it unfolds.
4. He proleptically referenced events that would later shape the outcome of the experiment.
