*Meaning: To prologize means to speak or write at length, often in a way that is overly detailed or tedious, leading to a loss of interest from the audience.*

3. To avoid confusion, it's better to get straight to the point rather than prologize excessively.
4. The professor warned students not to prologize in their essays, as clarity is key.
