Meaning: In a manner that involves making a promise or commitment to do something.

1. She promised to help me with my project, and she did so promissorially, ensuring every detail was perfect.
2. The contractor acted promissorially in his verbal agreement, leaving us with little recourse when he failed to deliver.
3. In a promissorially written letter, he assured her that he would always support her dreams and ambitions.
4. The team worked promissorially on their commitments, which ultimately led to their success in the competition.
5. Her promissorially expressed intentions made it clear that she was fully invested in the partnership from the start.
