Meaning: PROMPTER: A person or device that provides cues or reminders to actors during a performance to help them remember their lines or actions.

1. The actor glanced at the prompter for a cue during the live performance.
2. As a seasoned director, she often relied on the prompter to keep the actors on track.
3. In the theater, the prompter's quiet whispers ensured the show went on smoothly.
4. The prompter's voice was barely audible, but it was a lifeline for the nervous performers.
5. During rehearsals, the prompter helped the cast memorize their lines and stay focused.
