Meaning: To promulge means to formally announce or make known (a new law, regulation, or findings) to the public.

3. The university seeks to promulge its commitment to diversity through various outreach programs.
4. As part of the campaign, they will promulge the benefits of healthy living to encourage lifestyle changes.
5. To ensure transparency, the committee decided to promulge the results of the survey to all stakeholders.
