Meaning: Prone: likely to suffer from, experience, or do something, often as a result of a specific condition or tendency.

1. She is prone to making impulsive decisions without thinking them through.
2. The athlete was prone to injuries due to the intensity of his training regimen.
3. In the winter months, the region is prone to heavy snowfall and blizzards.
4. His tendency to procrastinate made him prone to last-minute stress before deadlines.
5. Children are often more prone to catching colds during the school year.
