

# PRONG

*Meaning: A prong is a pointed or projecting part, typically one of the tines of a fork or a branch of an antler.*

1. The fork had a single prong that made it difficult to pick up food.
2. Each antler of the deer had multiple prongs that seemed to reach out like fingers.
3. She carefully threaded the prong of the pitchfork into the hay bale.
4. The crown of the king was adorned with golden prongs that sparkled in the light.
5. The design of the tool included a sharp prong for piercing tough materials.
