Meaning: PROPED (verb): supported or held up in a particular position, often using an object to prevent movement or collapse.

1. The painter propped the canvas against the easel to examine his work from a distance.
2. She propped the door open with a heavy rock to let the fresh air in.
3. He propped himself up on his elbows to get a better view of the sunset.
4. The children propped their bikes against the fence while they played in the park.
5. Books were propped haphazardly on the shelf, creating a charming, cozy atmosphere.
