

PROPITIATION

Meaning: Propitiation is the act of appeasing or gaining the favor of a deity or spirit, often through rituals or sacrifices.

1. The ancient ritual was seen as a propitiation to appease the restless spirits of the forest.
2. In many cultures, sacrifice serves as a means of propitiation for the wrongs committed against deities.
3. The villagers believed that their offerings would serve as a propitiation to bring rain for their crops.

5. The concept of propitiation highlights the deep human desire to restore harmony in relationships.
