Meaning: In a manner intended to appease or placate someone, often to gain favor or forgiveness.

1. She looked at him propitiatorily, hoping to soothe his anger with a gentle smile.
2. The villagers offered sacrifices propitiatorily, seeking favor from the ancient spirits.
3. He spoke propitiatorily, trying to mend the rift caused by his thoughtless words.
4. With a propitiatory gesture, she extended her hand in friendship after their disagreement.
5. The diplomat addressed the crowd propitiatorily, aiming to calm the rising tensions.
